For households exceeding the income guidelines outlined in the attached application (page 8, 2024 HHS Poverty Guidelines), the cost is \$350 per school year per program or \$35 per month for 10 months. We are actively seeking grants and scholarships to make the program free for all students in the future.
- Transportation: Transportation will be provided from Clark County Public Middle and High Schools.
- Open House Sign-Up: There is no need to sign up for the open house. You and your student(s) are welcome to attend by simply showing up on the day of the event.
